We respond to situations of need via confidential referrals processes from multiple agencies and care workers across central Bedfordshire.


All our delivery teams are CRB checked, approved by the leadership teams of the partner churches and have signed confidentiality agreements.


How we operate

How much have we taken out?




The December 2013 data does not include the Christmas Hampers, which amounted to 280 in total which is roughly £12,600 worth of food. We are amazed at God's wonderful provision through you that made such a difference to many many families across our region.

The table below shows the growing need, with a running average of 74% increase.



Communities Served By Each Distribution Hub from January 2013.




