




Change in number of parcels 2020- 2022




The reasons people are being referred for food parcels & how many have a disability




Age distribution

In addition to the 453 food parcels and 805 Christmas Hampers distributed in December, we have given over 300 bags of fresh food out at the Pop-up sessions in Stotfold, Sandy & Shefford, with an approximate value of £8.00 each

Food donated by supermarkets, that has just reached its best before date and would otherwise be disposed of and wasted.

The total value of food shared in December reached the staggering sum of £95287.00.

With an additional £18,000.00 of presents also distributed.

We are continuing to provide food for refugees as required.





We are currently spending around £700 per month on fuel, collecting food and delivering food parcels in the villages around Central Bedfordshire.
