The amount of food parcels delivered is up by 18 this month based on June 2024. In July 2023 we delivered 403 food parcels. This is an increase of 90% in food parcels delivered.

This month with your help. We have managed to make a difference to 1,680 adults, 274 pensioners and 1,526 children. This includes our best before food that we give away.




Change in number of parcels 2021- 2024




