

In January 2024 we delivered 667 food parcels. This is an increase of nearly 27% in food parcels delivered this month vs the same month last year.

This month with your help. We have managed to make a difference to 1,301 adults, 83 pensioners and 1,018 children. This includes our best before food that we give away..




Change in number of parcels 2021- 2025




