

In August 2025 we delivered 504 food parcels and 457 top up bags. A review of our procedures has resulted in increased efficiencies which reflects in the top up bags rising and the parcels levelling out.

This month with your help. We have managed to make a difference to 754 adults, 34 pensioners and 613 children. This includes our best before food that we give away..










